


You may contact Richard once you are on the way to Labuan Bajo/Komodo to discuss your travel plans/arrival times/meeting point. For anything booking related, please contact your respective agent prior to travelling, unless you booked with us directly.

Meeting point in Labuan Bajo:

The meeting point in Labuan Bajo is at the main harbour, commonly referred to as 'KP3'. Please see the maps below:



If you have access to Google Maps, you may use 'Angel Island Eco Resort Boat Shuttle' as a reference point for directions:



* Meeting time is 11:00 *

The meeting point is on the corner next to the main building, directly next to the jetty where we will greet you and take you to our speedboat, onwards to Akomo Isseki. If coming in by car, the carpark/parking is right next to this point.

One of our cruise team will be waiting there from 11:00 onwards, holding a sign with 'Akomo Isseki' followed by your names written on it.

* We aspire to depart by 12:00 at the latest. *

Please note, it is recommended to arrive 1 day prior to the trip to avoid potential delays of flights.

Payments onboard:

At the end of the trip, we will produce a bill for you which will cover Park and Harbour Fees, Dive Equipment Rental (if required) and any other additional costs such as drinks consumed on board.

Payments may be made in cash IDR (only IDR, no other currency) or via Wise transfer (formerly Transferwise) where you can pay us from your currency to ours - we highly recommend downloading this very useful app.

* We do not accept any cash currencies other than IDR - Indonesian Rupiah. *

Park fees:

IDR 3,000,000 per person - as above, to be paid in cash IDR or via Wise Transfer, at the end of the trip.

Unfortunately, the above fees are subject to change. Regulations are constantly changing within Komodo, but we will do our best to inform you in good time if these fees are to increase/decrease before you join us.

Crew Tip:

On Average, most guests usually give anywhere between IDR 150,000 to IDR 250,000 per day of the trip each. This is merely a recommendation and rough guideline for you. Dive guide tips are separate and may be given as wished.

Dive Equipment Recommendations and Rental Costs:

IDR 500,000 per day for a full set including computer (please see our equipment rental price list for a full breakdown).

We have 3mm long wetsuits onboard. Water temperature usually ranges from 22-28 degrees celsius. It can start to get cold in Komodo and we highly recommend bringing a 5mm wetsuit with you if you have one.

There are many stingy nutrients/plankton (fish food) in these waters which is why we recommend at least a long rash guard or indeed a full long wetsuit.

Documentation:

Please make sure that you have filled in your registration forms correctly and clearly. We highly recommended signing them digitally. This will save you the hassle of printing out and signing everything by hand. The final page of our registration form is a Liability Release form. It is very important that this is signed correctly. You must put your name in the blank space at the top "I understand that" and sign and date at the bottom of the form. Again, this can be signed digitally.

We also require a clear copy of your passport photo page. This is required for harbour and immigration clearance. Please also bring along your dive certification card if you possess one.

Don't forget to bring your diving certification with you!

Travel Costs:

There are many ATM's in Labuan Bajo, including at the airport. There are also a few places where you can exchange foreign currencies, although we recommend using an ATM upon arrival or pre-arranging IDR currency before your arrival.

Please note that, whilst we do not pre-arrange transfers to and from the meeting point, before or after the trip, we are more than happy to assist you or offer any advice you may require upon arrival/leaving us.

1 car from the airport/hotel to hotel/harbour will usually cost anywhere between IDR 50,000 and 150,000.

It is very easy to arrange transport either directly from the airport, or from your hotel. If you require any help or assistance with Indonesian language/speaking with locals, please do not hesitate to contact us.

Final Recommendations:

We recommend bringing a reusable plastic/metal bottle or flask with you onboard. It is very useful for drinking water onboard and an eco-friendly option.

We also recommend bringing a spare towel with you, for after diving.

Komodo can get cold when it is windy, especially after a dive. We recommend bringing a long hoodie/jacket with you.

You are welcome to bring any snacks/treats/spirits or wine onboard with you. We stock coca-cola, sprite and canned beers (Bintang) onboard - if you require something more specific, please let us know well in advance.
